The Marathon Figure Skating Club provides recreational and test-stream skating instruction to youth members of our community. We provide a Canskate program for children as young as 3 years old that teaches basic skating and safety skills on the ice. Beyond the Canskate program, we offer recreational and test stream development of our skaters. The test stream program involves advancement through Skate Canada national test levels. Our recreational skaters choose to continue their skill development and enjoyment of the sport without trying tests. MFSC contracts one full-time head coach who is responsible for group instruction at all levels.



Registration for Winter Skate must be received by September 27, 2010 to determine number of skaters. After September 27, there will be an additional late registration fee of \$25. Postdated cheques are acceptable along with the application form.

No refunds will be issued after October 15, 2010 without a medical certificate. Requests must be made in writing to the MFSC executive within 4 weeks of being off the ice and accompanied by a medical certificate.
